COVID-19 Update

As we shared in a special E-news COVID-19 update sent on Thursday morning, Kyle Wilson, our Associate Pastor of Student Ministries, received confirmation of a positive test for COVID-19 late Wednesday night. Please be in prayer for Kyle and his family as he recovers at home.

As we also noted in the E-news update, Kyle was at UBC on Sunday for services. However, he was not experiencing any symptoms until Monday and he has been working from home since Monday morning. He followed our staff safety protocols for Sunday morning, including getting a temperature check on arrival and wearing a mask while in the building except for when eating or drinking or working at one's desk. He was onstage for the welcome in both services and he spoke without a mask, but that is also part of our normal protocol. Speakers are allowed to remove their masks when the speaker's words are not being shown on the screen. Typically, that happens during the welcome, the prayer, the sermon and the announcement time.

We know these are difficult times, and we are trying to be as transparent as possible while also balancing individuals' privacy. Again, please join us in praying for a quick recovery for Kyle and the others in our community suffering from COVID-19.
