



COVID-19 UPDATE

Since the outbreak of the pandemic early this year, UBC has been diligent about detailing safety measures and protocols for our staff and for how our building is maintained. The fact that we have avoided outbreaks of COVID-19 onsite over this time is evidence that our protocols have been working.

Out of an abundance of caution, it is our policy to notify the staff and the congregation when a pastoral/director level staff member receives a positive COVID test.

This morning, Tuesday, Nov. 17, Laura Davis, our Director of Weekday Ministries, received confirmation of a positive test for COVID-19. Laura has not been at UBC since last Tuesday, Nov. 10. In accordance with our protocols, Laura started a self-quarantine period on Wednesday, Nov. 11, when she discovered that she may have been exposed to someone who tested positive for the virus. She began experiencing symptoms four days later, Nov. 15, and was tested that same day. Again, she received a positive result today, but has been at home for the past week.

This does not necessarily indicate you need to take any additional actions. This notification is a part of our standard awareness policy. Please refer to the CDC website for their recommendations.
