

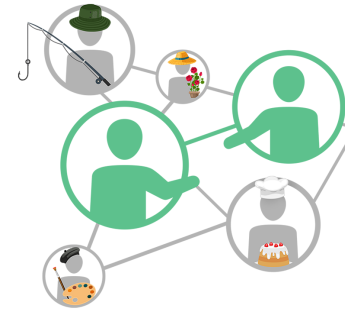


The Second Congregational Conversation!
